Will you be joining your Meyers friends for the 2023 International Meyers Flyin?

The Silver State is looking forward to welcoming us to the Nevada Capital of Carson City.

In 1861, the writer Mark Twain added to the notoriety of Carson City by publishing the following description:

"It nestled in the edge of a great plain and was a sufficient number of miles away to look like an assemblage of mere white spots. The mountain summits overlooking it seemed lifted clear out of companionship and consciousness of earthly things."

Although Mark Twain visited Carson City NV almost 162 years ago in 1861, the city is still considered a town that is dominated by its spectacular setting. Carson City maintains the charm of its 1860s gold and silver town roots.



Fun Facts about Carson City, NV

1. Carson City has a population of 58,639 located in a protected valley surrounded on all sides by mountains featuring the dramatic peaks of the Sierra Nevada to the west and south. Carson City is located 30 minutes east of Lake Tahoe, 30 minutes south of Reno, 20 minutes west of Virginia City and 25 minutes north of Minden and Gardnerville in Carson Valley.

2. Founded in 1858 on the site of Eagle Station (later Eagle Ranch), it took its name from the nearby Carson River, which the explorer John C. Frémont, who explored the region in 1843–44, named for his scout, Christopher ("Kit") Carson.

3. Carson City was selected as the state capital at the constitutional convention and has retained that honor to the present day. Following the discovery of gold and silver on the nearby Comstock Lode in 1859, Carson City became a thriving commercial center.

4. Carson City was recognized by the Guinness World Records for its Nevada State Prison, from which Leonard T. Fristoe made the longest recorded escape by a recaptured prisoner lasting until he reached age 77. Leonard had enjoyed almost 46 years of freedom under an alias until his son turned him in.

5. Guinness World Records also points to Carson City as being a site for the 1988 Women's International Bowling Congress Championship tournament which attracted 77,735 bowlers over 96 days from March 31 to July 4, 2004. This event represents the most participants in a women's sporting event ever.

### Planning your trip to Carson City, NV

#### Climate:

Carson City has a semi-arid climate with hot summers and cool winters. The area experiences low levels of precipitation throughout the year with occasional heavy rainstorms in the winter months.

Carson City, Nevada gets 9 inches of rain, on average, per year / US average is 38 inches of rain per year.

Carson City averages 17 inches of snow per year / US average is 28 inches of snow per year.

On average, there are 253 sunny days per year in Carson City / US average is 205 sunny days.

Carson City gets some kind of precipitation, on average, 43 days per year. Precipitation is rain, snow, sleet, or hail that falls to the ground. In order for precipitation to be counted you have to get at least .01 inches on the ground to measure.


#### Driving:
