Due to this being a private airfield, it demands Special Operating Procedures (SOPs) to be always complied with to keep everyone safe and happy. We are welcomed guests to Spruce Creek and the Board of Directors has granted special permission for our Meyers group to utilize the facilities. LOCATION INFORMATION

Spruce Creek Fly-In is conveniently located in Port Orange Florida 2 miles off I-95. For travel by airline, Daytona Airport (DAB) is located 20 minutes north, Sanford (SFB) Airport 20 minutes south, and Orlando (MCO) Airport 70 minutes south. All airports have rental car accessibility.

AIRCRAFT ARRIVALS & DEPARTURES

7FL6 is located 7 miles south of Daytona Airport under the Class B shelf. Please be vigilant when arriving to Spruce Creek, maintaining no more than 1,200 ft. TPA is 1,025 ft. All radio calls must be made while in the pattern and on the ground. We cannot emphasize this enough. There will be many aircraft operating in and around the area.

Both runways 06 and 24 have displaced thresholds. Additionally, due to the runway's 4000' length and 176' width, the approach will give a false sight line as being very short in distance. Trees on both ends will also cause a slight disruption of wind upon crossing the 1000 ft markers. VASI lights are used and can be viewed on the left side of the runway. As always SEE AND AVOID!

ARRIVAL CHECK-IN AREA

Upon landing, proceed to Cessna Blvd. $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way down to the location marked on the below map. There will be a marshal to guide you to check-in parking. The plan is to gather as many arriving aircraft at check-in then mass taxi to the final tie-down area located east of the approach end of runway 24 off of taxiway Romeo.
